Rueil-Malmaison, 31st **March 2025** - Ingerop has acquired Hyna + Weiß. With this operation, we are broadening our range of services by integrating skills in civil engineering and road infrastructure. This acquisition is part of a long-standing relationship of trust between our two companies. It marks a new strategic step in Ingerop's development in Germany.

From an established partnership to integration into the Ingerop group

Founded in 1990 by Reinhard Hyna, Hyna + Weiß Bauingenieure GmbH is an engineering firm specialising in civil engineering and topography. The company, now run by Robert Hyna and Christian Weiß, is based in Friedberg, Bavaria, and employs a staff of 16. Its expertise covers all phases of road infrastructure project planning and implementation, integrating an ecological and social dimension into each project. Its most significant local references include the three-lane widening of the B17, flood protection in Murnau and the Pfaffenhofen an der Glonn bypass.

The collaboration between Hyna + Weiß and Ingerop began around ten years ago. Our companies are currently working together on the design of high-voltage electrical links between northern and southern Germany for TenneT. The integration of Hyna + Weiß into the Ingerop Group will enable us to develop strong synergies and accelerate our joint growth.





Ambitious synergy: aiming for major multidisciplinary engineering and offering high added-value services

Despite a more than positive growth dynamic and a doubling of its turnover between 2020 and 2024, Hyna + Weiß was faced with a structural limitation due to its size. Joining an international group like Ingerop will enable it to benefit from its strike force and give it the opportunity to access larger-scale projects and extend its scope of intervention.

For Ingerop, this acquisition meets a highly strategic challenge: to strengthen its expertise in civil engineering and road infrastructure in Germany and thus be able to submit comprehensive bids for large-scale road and motorway projects, including linear and underground structures. This extension of skills will also enable our group to respond to new markets and to bid independently on the invitations to tender concerned: this is the case for IRVE projects - Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructures - thanks to the synergy between the expertise in electrical infrastructure engineering of Ingerop Deutchland and the road infrastructure expertise of Hyna + Weiß. The acquisition will also enable the company to strengthen its local presence in Bavaria, with a new site in the region.

Yves Metz, Chairman of the Ingerop Group, said: "This acquisition is above all a wonderful human adventure and is part of the natural evolution of a fruitful and long-term collaboration between our two companies. As we share the same values and the same vision of engineering at the service of territories, we wanted to go further in what we could bring to each other. Combined, our different areas of expertise will enable us to boost our two entities in Germany with complementary, high added-value services.

Robert Hyna and Christian Weiß, co-directors of Hyna + Weiß, added: "By joining Ingerop, we wanted to reach a new level in terms of growth and development. We are convinced that this merger will enable us to take a new step forward, in particular by bringing our expertise to larger-scale projects. We now have many new opportunities open to us, both for our staff and for our customers.

Germany, a strategically important market for the Ingerop group

Present in Germany since the end of 2018, Ingerop is continuing its development with this fifth acquisition in six years.

Ingerop Deutschland now employs more than 400 people and has more than doubled in size since its creation.
